("PetroFrontier") representing 0.23% of the outstanding Shares. Together with Shares already held by Heritage, the Company now holds 8,977,000 Shares, representing approximately 14.14% of the outstanding Shares of PetroFrontier.

The Shares were acquired through the facilities of the TSX Venture Exchange for an aggregate price equal to CDN\$225,881. Heritage may increase or decrease its ownership of securities of PetroFrontier depending upon future market conditions.

All Shares acquired and/or held by Heritage in PetroFrontier were acquired for investment purposes.
